You should plan on sending your course requests as soon as your first registration pass begins. Do not wait until you arrive at UCLA to enroll in psychology courses. Classes will most likely be full by that time.

[Syllabi for psychology](#) courses are generally not posted until the quarter begins. The syllabus for a particular course may vary from one instructor to another.

Once you have thoroughly researched your courses and have checked the [Schedule of Classes](#) to verify that times and days of classes do not coincide, you should send an [e-mail](#) regarding the courses you would like to register for (including alternative options in case first choice classes are closed). Any questions you may have regarding prerequisites for courses should also be addressed in your [e-mail](#). Be sure to include your student ID number.
